ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 21/25.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2, whereby, petitioner was transferred from Panipat to Sirsa, allegedlyin violation of the Government Policy dated 07.04.1989 (Annexure P-3).

2. While issuing notice of motion, vide an order dated 01.03.2019, stay was granted on the impugned transfer order. More than 3 years have passed since then. However, petitioner has been continuing at Panipat by virtue of interim stay granted by this Court. Interim stay has already outlived its utility period and/ or mitigating circumstances, if any.

Even though an adjournment slip has been filed by learned counsel for the petitioner, but I see no grounds to adjourn the matter. Same

seems to be merely an attempt to prolong the proceedings before this Court, taking advantage of the interim stay granted in favour of the petitioner.

3. No grounds for further indulgence are made out.

4. Dismissed.

5. However, dismissal of the writ petition shall not be construed, in any manner, to mean that in case administrative exigency does not warrant, even then the petitioner has to be now necessarily transferred. The said decision is left to the discretion of the competent authority.
