Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0063 dated 1.2.2020 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra.

By virtue of the order dated 8.7.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 8.7.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same. Counsel further submits that the parties appeared before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court and settled their dispute amicably.
