This order shall dispose of CRM-M-12763-2021, CRM-M-12776-2021 and CRM-M-12812-2021.

The petitioner is seeking to quash 1) FIR No.013 dated

29.01.2021 under Sections 354-A, 354-D and 506 IPC registered at Police

Station West Sector-11, District Chandigarh; 2) FIR No. 386 dated 29.10.2020 under Sections 452, 506 and 509 IPC registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal and 3) FIR No.06 dated 20.01.2019 under Sections 354-A, 354-D, 506 and 384 IPC (Sections 380 and 411 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandahr.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the compromise between the parties has fizzled out and respondent No.2 does not intend to enter into any amicable settlement with the petitioner. She intends to contest the case in the trial Court on merits.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw all the three petitions.
