1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 143, dated 10th November, 2019, under Section 420 of IPC, 1860 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural, on the basis of compromise.
2. Vide order dated 26th March, 2021, the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court regarding the genuineness of the compromise.
3. On the last date, none appeared for the petitioner and the private respondent. Trial Court report was received that parties did not appear for getting their statements recorded.
4. The petitioner and private respondent are unrepresented even today. Considering that the compromise itself is in doubt, the petition is dismissed.
