The Prayer in this petition is for the grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC in case FIR No.52 dated 29.05.2021 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326, 506 and 427 IPC registered with Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner states that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the injury attracting Section 326 IPC has been attributed to Ajay co-accused with the sword on the hands of Krishan. He further states that one Raman from the side of petitioner-accused has received some injuries which are unexplained and therefore, it is a case of version and cross version. Three other co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of regular bail vide orders

Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-5.

The learned State Counsel fairly concedes that the petitioner is in custody since 23.11.2021 and the challan has already been presented on 19.01.2022. The further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

I have heard the rival contentions of both the parties and deem it appropriate to allow regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. Petitioner-Naveen son of Sh. Rajbir Kalra is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed herein above, would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the cases.
