[1] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned State Counsel, on instructions from the respondent states that the appeal filed by the petitioner would be decided within 04 weeks from today.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the assurance held out by the respondent through the learned State Counsel, he does not press the instant petition but prays that the respondent be directed to adhere to the assurance held out by him through the learned State Counsel and decide the appeal in a time bound manner.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned State Counsel, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any orders against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondent to adhere to the assurance held out by him through the learned State Counsel and decide the appeal within 04

weeks from today and to communicate the decision taken thereon to the petitioner through Registered post within 01 week thereafter.
