SANT PARKASH, J.

The petitioner is aggrieved of the order dated 15.11.2021 (P-1) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur as well as order dated 02.04.2019 (P-2) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dasuya, vide which the petitioner has been directed to deposit the sale proceeds of 700 bags of wheat after making videography and photography while disposing off the case property.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The limited prayer of the petitioner would be that instead of directing to deposit the sale proceeds of 700 bags of wheat, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to furnish the bank guarantee to an equivalent amount realised from the said sale proceeds.

Learned counsel for the State has no objection if the above-said prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The

impugned orders are modified to the extent that the petitioner shall furnish the bank guarantee to an equivalent amount realised from the sale proceeds of 700 bags of wheat.
