Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.7 dated 03.02.2022, registered for offences under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 23.03.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated with the Investigating Officer. Still further, it has been submitted by counsel for the petitioner that petitioner's name has been kept in column No.2 and he has not been arrayed as an accused. Still further, he submits that the entire prosecution evidence is almost over.

This fact has been confirmed by the State counsel upon instructions received from ASI, Surjit.

In view of the above development, petition has become infructuous.
