The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking quashing of order dated 17.02.2021 whereby Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khamanon had issued non-bailable warrants. As per status report dated 31.03.2021 filed by the respondent-State, non-bailable warrants were issued on 01.04.2021 and Police Station Khamanon, received copy of the orders passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court on 22.02.2021. In view of the orders dated 09.02.2021 of Hon'ble Supreme Court, the petitioner was not arrested and no further action in compliance of warrants was initiated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that Hon'ble Supreme Court dismissed petition of the petitioner on 23.08.2022 and petitioner surrendered before the trial Court on 30.08.2022.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
