The petitioners have challenged the order dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P3) passed by the Educational Tribunal, Punjab ('Tribunal' - for short) (respondent No. 1) whereby respondent No. 2 has been reinstated with continuity of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that respondent No.2, who was working as a Professor, had himself abandoned his service, as he had not worked w.e.f. 01.11.2019 and, therefore, he ought not to have been reinstated in service.

Heard.

Respondent No. 2 is stated to have been appointed as a Professor in the petitioner-College on 10.02.2010. He had gone to join duty on 01.11.2019 and when he was not allowed to join duty, he had served a legal notice on the petitioner-College on 22.11.2019. I am in agreement with the order of the Tribunal that there was no material to indicate that respondent No. 2 had abandoned his service. No notice had been issued to him in this

regard. He had served for about nine years and no notice for initiating disciplinary proceedings had been issued to him by the petitioner-College.

In view of the above, I do not find any infirmity in the impugned order (Annexure P3) warranting interference by this Court while exercising writ jurisdiction.

Consequently, the writ petition is dismissed.
