The petitioner herein seeks directions to promote him to the rank of D.S.P. from the date his juniors had been promoted, with all consequential benefits.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this regard, the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice/representation dated 13.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) before the respondents, but till date, no decision has been taken thereon. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his legal notice/representation is decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide legal notice/representation dated 13.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
