As the main petition is fixed today, the prayer made in the application has been rendered infructuous.

Main petition

This is a petition seeking direction to respondent No. 4- Sukhwinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Crime, Moga not to make multiple enquiries at the instance of respondent No. 5 in case of FIR No. 146 dated 29.7.2021, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamkot.

The grievance is that inspite of one enquiry held, notices have been issued for initiating subsequent enquiry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the instructions issued by Director General of Police and the decisions of Supreme Court and this Court to the effect that multiple enquiries cannot be held.

The petition is disposed of at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to take all the pleas by way of a detailed reply to the notices.

At this stage, Mr. Mehta, Senior DAG, Punjab appearing on advance notice submits that in case reply is filed, the same would be considered and decided in accordance with law by passing a speaking order.
