The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing appropriate directions for initiating proceedings against the persons responsible for twice replacing of 610 pages of exhibited documents, first before hearing of revision by Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar and later after reconstruction of record when the records were summoned by the High Court from the judicial file of Criminal complaint Case No. 24 of 2009 registered under Sections 306, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 7/13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, pending in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that in the present case, the trial is completed and the accused person has been acquitted and in view of the same, present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of, in view of the abovesaid order.
