[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for taking action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/4 dated 28.10.2021 in CWP No.21235 of 2021 in case titled as Kuldeep Singh vs. Punjabi University Patiala, Patiala and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/4 dated 28.10.2021 reveals that CWP No.21235 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the legal notice served by the petitioner and take necessary action in respect thereto in accordance with law, if so warranted, in the facts and circumstances of the case by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has produced copy of speaking order dated 21.02.2022 passed by respondent No.2 rejecting the claim of the petitioner. Speaking order dated 21.02.2022 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel

press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 21.02.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 21.02.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
