Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for the post of welfare organization which was advertised by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission and exam was held on 17.07.2021 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of his aforesaid grievance, petitioner has submitted a representation dated Nil (Annexure P-7) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation dated Nil (Annexure P-7), in due course.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending representation dated Nil (Annexure P-7).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated Nil (Annexure P-7) and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
