Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 04.02.2021, under Sections 406/498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women, Amritsar City.

Vide order dated 01.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 01.11.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation. He submits that though the parties were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where they duly appeared, however, the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner. He submits that the mediation failed because of adamant attitude of the petitioner. He further

submits that the petitioner used to beat the complainant and due to which,

her surgery of the ear took place.

Learned State counsel submits that as per their investigation so far, there is no MLR and the one produced by the complainant pertains to some private hospital. He has further submitted that as per the investigation so far, the allegations pertaining to the injury referred back to July, 2019 whereas present FIR was filed in 4th February, 2021. He has affirmed that the petitioner has joined investigation in pursuance to order dated 01.11.2021 passed by this Court.

After hearing counsel for the parties, it is apparent that there is nothing on record regarding criminal antecedents of the petitioner. He has duly joined investigation. Hence the interim order dated 01.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
