[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings
against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order,
Annexure P-1, dated 26.10.2018, in CWP No.1929 of 2018 in case titled as
'Lohgarh Cooperative L&C Society Ltd. versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.1929
of 2018 was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the
claim made by the petitioner in the legal notice and take a decision on the
same at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks from 26.10.2018.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner states that needful having been done in terms of order (Annexure
P-1) dated 26.10.2018 and legal notice having been decided, the petitioner
does not wish to pursue the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of
learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not
calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts
Act, 1971.
