1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 18.12.2019, in CWP-22036-2016.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that operation of order in CWP-22036-2016, has been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA-621-2020 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage with liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition on vacation of stay or decision of LPA in favour of the petitioner, whichever is earlier.

3. The aforementioned course of action is not opposed to by the learned AAG, Punjab.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, at this stage, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
