AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

Present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 not to conduct multiple inquiries on the same complaint as per the mandate of law laid down in Jaswinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others and in view of the letter dated 01.04.2008 issued by respondent No.2.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 05.03.2019, pursuant to which reply dated 05.08.2019 by way of affidavit of Shamsher Singh, PPS, DSP, Payal had been filed. Learned State counsel makes a reference to paras 2 and 3 which read thus:-

2. That after hearing both the parties and after going through the orders dated 05-03-2019 passed by this Hon'ble High Court, the application is recommended to be consigned, in compliance of the orders of this Hon'ble High Court.

3. That no further inquiry is being conducted and the applications are recommended to be consigned. The further action will be taken as per the orders of the Hon'ble High Court. At present, no action is being taken by the answering respondents in the matter. The orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court and directions issued by the Hon'ble Director General Police, Punjab, Chandigarh. True translated copy of the report of respondent no. 4 is attached herewith as ANNEXURE R-1/7

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
