Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking grant of parole for a period of 4 weeks to the petitioner under Section 3 (1) (b) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 to enable the petitioner to participate in the marriage of his sister, which is scheduled for 02.04.2022 and 03.04.2022.

Notice was issued to the State. A short reply by way of an affidavit of Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Karnal has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and a communication bearing No.3961 dated 29.03.2022 has been filed by the State counsel during the course of hearing today, which is taken on record.

Heard counsel for the parties.

A perusal of the communication dated 29.03.2022 shows that the wedding of the sister of the petitioner is fixed on 03.04.2022 at a marriage palace at Karnal. This Court is of the view that the presence of the petitioner at the time of performance of marriage ceremonies is necessary.

Accordingly, it is ordered that the petitioner, who is lodged in District Prison, Karnal, be taken to the venue of the marriage in the morning on 03.04.2022 in police custody as per rules and be brought back to the Jail premises in the evening of the same day.

Superintendent, District Prison, Karnal is directed to make necessary arrangements.

Petition is disposed of.
