This petition is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 124, dated 28th December, 2021, under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Malerkotla.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sahibdeen raised an objection that petitioner has not approached the Court with clean hands. He is involved in four cases out of which two are under the Excise Act, one under NPDS Act and one under the IPC, whereas in petition it has been pleaded that he is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has not instructed him properly. Considering the conduct of his client, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
