In the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is for the release of 100% family pension rather than 50%, which is being released to her, on the ground of being sole claimant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the respondents have withheld 50% of the family pension by placing reliance on Note-2 of Rule 6.17 of Civil Services Rule, Volume-II, which note has already been clarified by this Court in **CWP No.20374 of 2017** titled **Jaspal Kaur and others versus State of Punjab and others**, decided on 11.02.2022.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per her instructions from ASI (LR) Rajwinder Singh, there is no other claimant except the petitioner to receive the family pension as all other claimants have either died or have become ineligible to receive the family pension.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the present petition be also disposed of in the terms of **Jaspal Kaur (supra)**.

Ordered accordingly.
