The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.75 dated 29.11.2018 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Samalsar, District Moga.

On March 03, 2020, this Court had passed the following order:-

“It is contended that the petitioner was declared to be innocent by the Investigating Agency during investigation and was not challaned. However, on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. having been filed by the prosecution the accused has been summoned to face trial.

Notice of motion.

The accused is directed to appear in the trial Court within 7 days from today. In the event of his doing so, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

It is not disputed that in pursuance to the afore-quoted order, the petitioner appeared before the Sessions Judge, Moga on 07.03.2020 and was admitted to interim bail.

In view of the submissions recorded in the afore-quoted order; the petitioner having shown his bona fide by appearing before the Trial Court; the Trial Court having admitted the petitioner to interim bail and

because nearly two years have lapsed since the petitioner was admitted to ad-interim bail, during which period he has not misused such concession, the afore-quoted order of this Court dated 03.03.2020 is ordered to be made absolute.
