This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 405 dated 17.07.2020 under Sections 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, other than respondent No. 2, there are two more victims which is apparent from a reading of the FIR.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the necessary persons as party in the present case.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
