[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.01.2017 in CWP No.27313 of 2016 in case titled as Gursewak Singh Bhullar vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.01.2017 reveals that CWP No.27313 of 2016 was disposed of by the directing the respondents to consider and decide representation dated 29.10.2014 within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was held entitled to promotion along with all consequential benefits, to grant the same to the petitioner.

[3] Learned AAG has placed on record copy of order dated 18.06.2021 rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 18.06.2021

passed by respondent No.3, Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
