By this petition, the petitioners seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.31, dated 25.02.2022, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 24.05.2022, learned State counsel submits, on instructions from HC Gursewak Singh, that petitioner no.2- Jagsir Singh, has joined investigation and presently at least his custodial interrogation is not required.

The petition *qua* petitioner no.1 has already been dismissed as not pressed vide the aforesaid order.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the order dated 24.05.2022, made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
