Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 to 6 not to harass the petitioner.

Short affidavit of Sucha Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Batala, Police District Batala on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 6 has been filed. The relevant extract of the affidavit is reproduced as under:-

2. That it is respectfully submitted that all the SHO's in Police District Batala have been given instruments vide Memo No. 83-WPC dated 18/03/2017 by the office of Senior Superintendent of Police Batala that Tarun Kumar son of Sh. Kali Dass aged about 25 years resident of H.No. B-14/205, Mohalla Balmiki, Khajuri Gate, Batala, District Gurdaspur must not be harassed as his innocence has already been proved out further directions have been given to arrest the accused Vijay Kumar S/o Banarsi Dass resident of Chatti Gali, Daula Nangal, Near Vivekanand School, Khajuri Gate, Batala, who is involved in many theft cases.

3. That it is respectfully submitted that the Life and Liberty of

the petitioner will be protected. It is further submitted that Vijay Kumar accused is not Vijay Kumar @ Tarun and the name of Tarun Kumar has been unnecessarily used by Vijay Kumar stating Vijay Kumar @ Tarun Kumar. It is also pertinent to mention here that strenuous sincere efforts are being made to arrest the real accused Vijay Kumar wanted in many theft cases in Police District Batala.

In view of the averments contained in the aforesaid affidavit and as extracted above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
