The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.19 dated 6.1.2019 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

At the outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the parties that in pursuance to the order dated 18.1.2022, the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre and have finally settled the dispute amicably.

Report of the Mediator has also been received affirming the fact of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Although there was no order of joining the investigation by the petitioner, however, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.
