1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 14.10.2019, in CRM-M-43463-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 14.10.2019, reveals that CRM-M-43463-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the grievance of the petitioner as raised by him vide representation dated 08.08.2019 and take appropriate action as warranted in respect thereto, in accordance with law.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from SI, Tarwinder Kumar, P.S. Mallout, Police District Khanna, states that three accused were arrested on 17.07.2019 and that pursuant to representation dated 08.08.2019 from the petitioner, one more accused was arrested on 06.02.2020, but no case was made out for adding any other offence other than Sections 323, 325, 506, 149 of IPC, in FIR No.56 dated 11.07.2019, registered at Police Station Maloud, District Ludhiana, or for transferring the investigation to some other police station.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same as he is satisfied with the action taken.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
