The present petition has been filed for quashing of complaint No.69 dated 27.01.2015, under Sections 452, 382, 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC, titled as 'Prem Parihar Vs. Rajvir Sharma etc.', and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, including the summoning order dated 07.03.2017 (Annexure P-4).

At the outset, learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties, and that vide order dated 27.02.2018 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the aforesaid offences were compounded with the permission of the Court and the accused persons were discharged.

The aforesaid factual position has not been denied by the

learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

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In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed
having become infructuous.
