The case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ seeking direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Pursuant to the order dated 22.03.2021, a reply by way of affidavit of Gajender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Assandh, Karnal, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 has been filed. The same is taken on record.

A perusal of the abovesaid reply shows that respondents have specifically averred that petitioners had not been called in the premises of police station or extended any harassment by them. The aforesaid reply is accompanied by an affidavit sworn by petitioner No.1 where she has stated

to withdraw the present criminal writ petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner pleads ignorance. However, he is not in a position to controvert the status report.

Dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
