The present petition has been filed under Section 4439(2) Cr.P.C praying for cancellation of interim bail granted vide order dated 15.1.2019 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Ludhiana and order dated 21.1.2019 granting absolute anticipatory bail to the accused Gurnam Singh in case FIR No.0002 dated 4.1.2019 registered under section 376 IPC at Police Station, Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Present petition is pending adjudication since 13.3.2019. Record of the case shows that for the previous three dates no one was present on behalf of the petitioner. Even today the position is the same.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajmer Singh has informed the court that the trial of the case is an advance stage as out of the total 10 prosecution witnesses 7 have already been examined. She has drawn attention of this court to the status report filed by way of affidavit of Harjinder Singh Gill, ACP, Industrial Area-A, Ludhiana, wherein it has been mentioned that the accused Gurnam Singh has not violated any terms and conditions of the bail order and he is duly appearing before the learned

Trial Court.

In view of the above circumstances and submissions made by learned State counsel, this court finds no ground to interfere in the impugned order dated 15.1.2019 (Annexure P-3) and the petition being devoid of any merit is, accordingly, dismissed.
