1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 24.11.2020, in CWP-3170-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 24.11.2020, reveals that CWP-3170-2020, was disposed of in terms of order in CWP-3252-2020, wherein the competent authority was directed to take a final decision in the matter with regard to entitlement of the petitioner to recover due payments in respect of work allegedly executed by him, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to recover the claimed amount or any other amount, then in the absence of any legal hitch, the same be released to the petitioner within one month from the date of final decision in the matter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1, dated 24.11.2020, the claim of the

petitioner has been decided and payment as per entitlement, released to the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
