This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 for taking action on application/representation dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner had become disciple of Parveen Mahant four years ago and is being harassed by him, Chann and Bikka and when she asked for money, they gave beatings to the petitioner. Learned counsel states that Parveen Mahant instead of asking the others to go from the dera, is asking the petitioner to leave. He submits that though the representation has been given for taking legal action, but till date nothing has been done and no protection has been provided to the petitioner. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

After hearing the learned counsel and perusing the complaint (Annexure P-1), this Court finds that the averments contained in the complaint are not only vague, but also lack necessary particulars and further, the memo of parties shows that the petitioner is still residing at the address of Parveen Mahant. The alleged manner and mode of threat has not

been described either in the representation or in the writ petition, therefore, these bald averments are not enough to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Resultantly, the petition fails and is dismissed.
