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**RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)**

Though this petition has been filed challenging rejection of the petitioner's technical bid pursuant to an NIT dated 08.02.2022 issued by the respondent-authorities, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-authorities, on advance copy, submits that NIT dated 08.02.2022 has itself been withdrawn by the authorities as only one tenderer was in fray and now the authorities have issued a fresh tender only yesterday. He further submits that the petitioner would be free to apply for the same and in case the petitioner does so, the authorities would consider and evaluate the same in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that nothing survives for adjudication in the petition and he may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to apply for the tender pursuant to the fresh notice issued by the respondent-authorities.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for both the parties and taking the same on record, the petition stands disposed of.
