Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0021 dated 23.02.2022 registered for offences under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, Faridabad (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant, has joined the investigation in deference to the order dated 14.09.2022 passed by this Court. Reference has also been made by him to the report received from the Mediation Centre that matter has

been amicably settled and a petition seeking divorce by mutual consent has been instituted.

Upon instructions from ASI Suman, State counsel has verified that the petitioner has joined the investigation. She submits that the petitioner has cooperated with the investigation process.

State counsel submits that the complainant has made a statement that she will get articles through the process of Court.

Keeping in view the fact that dispute has been settled, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 14.09.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
