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**ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)**

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash order dated 19.03.1998 (Annexure P-1) vide which representation given by the petitioner was rejected. Further prayer has been made to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to reject the claim of respondent No.3 for regularization.

2. Petition was filed in the year 1998 and has been lying admitted ever since.

3. On being asked to argue, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions. He submits that despite attempts, his office could not contact the petitioner. On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that not only the petitioner but even respondent No.3, whose date of regularization was under challenge, both have since retired on superannuation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.3, instant petition is dismissed as infructuous.
