Instant second petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0174, dated 18.08.2020, under Sections 366-A, 376, 109 IPC and Section 4 POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the concerned Court.

Allowed as prayed for.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the Court concerned. However, if the petitioners surrender within seven days from today and file an appropriate application, the concerned Court would decide the same expeditiously preferably within two days from the date of its filing, in accordance with law.
