Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0061 dated 13.04.2018, registered for offences under Sections 376 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”), at Police Station Division C, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the affidavit, Annexure P-2, executed by complainant-respondent No.2.

Counsel representing complainant-respondent No.2 submits that there is no compromise between the parties. Still further, he submits that an FIR has been registered against the petitioner for offence under Section 354-A, IPC and Section 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 on the complaint of complainant-respondent No.2 on the allegation that the petitioner has sexually abused her minor daughter.

In view of the above, prayer made in the petition cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
