The present petition has been filed for grant of the same relief as granted to the petitioners in CWP No. 2605 of 1998 titled as “R.K.Aggarwal and others vs. State of Punjab and others”.

Learned State counsel submits that on an appeal preferred by the State of Punjab before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide order dated 24.01.2020, the operation of the judgment, upon which the petitioner was relying for seeking relief, has already been stayed.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition at this stage with liberty to file a fresh one in case, after the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP No.45033 of 2019 titled as “State of Punjab and others vs. R.K.Aggarwal, and others” the right to claim relief still subsists with the petitioner.
