Prayer in this petition is for transfer of the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***Kulwant Singh vs. Rajwinder Kaur***, pending before the Family Court, SBS Nagar to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Hoshiarpur.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since a decree of divorce has already been granted in favour of the petitioner on 12.07.2022, the aforesaid petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, SBS Nagar, eventually become infructuous. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondent-husband.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that to the Principal Judge, Family Court, SBS Nagar to look into the aforesaid aspect and dispose of the main petition accordingly.
