Complaining the wilful disobedience of the direction issued on 16.12.2021 by the Additional Civil Judge, (Sr. Division) at Amloh, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the judgment reads as under:-

“9. Accordingly, the suit of the plaintiff succeeds ex parte and is hereby decreed ex parte with costs in favour of the plaintiff in the manner that if there is no charge/liability on suit property, the defendants are directed to hand over the original sale/title deed regarding the property no. 1021/1521 of the plaintiff, to the plaintiff and to issue No Objection Certificate regarding the property no. 1021/1521. Khasra no 2243/1190/247 situated at village Kukar Majra, Tehsil Amloh District Fatehgarh Sahib in the name of the plaintiff in accordance with law within 15 days on receipt of copy of this judgment. Decree sheet be drawn accordingly. File be consigned to the record room.”

There is a decree passed by the civil court for implementation thereof. Execution petition is maintainable. Hence, no ground to exercise the jurisdiction under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
