This petition is for quashing of FIR No. 264 dated 22.11.2019 registered under Sections 323, 342, 148, 149 IPC (Section 379-B IPC added subsequently) at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, on the basis of compromise dated 24.02.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Vide orders dated 04.03.2020 passed by this Court, the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court was directed to record the statements of all concerned parties with regard to the genuineness and validity or otherwise of the compromise.

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that all the petitioners have been acquitted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga, thus the present petition has become infructuous.
