The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.1 dated 2.1.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 506, 323, 376 IPC and Section3(1) of SC/ST Act, at Police Station Women, Karnal.

By virtue of the order dated 24.3.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, the same remained unsuccessful. He further submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the mediation has failed on account of adamant behaviour of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the present case, this Court finds that the matter requires to be decided on merits.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.3.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
