By this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking a direction to the respondents to consider the 'prayer of stay' within a time frame, in the appeal stated to be pending before respondent No.3 (Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Hisar). The petitioner has further prayed that the respondents be restrained from further creating third party rights or alienating the plot in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioner obviously restricts his prayer to the one made in the petition.

Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3—Administrator, HSVP, to dispose of the appeal dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-6), including any application filed along with it, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Naturally, this Court has not made any observations on the merits of the case, or whether such appeal is maintainable even in terms of limitation, which would be gone into by the Appellate Authority.
