The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondent, with a further prayer for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to conduct a free, fair and impartial investigation into the case FIR No.290 dated 13.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 306, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Barnala,

A status report dated 24.05.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 by the learned State counsel by way of the affidavit of Rajesh Snehi, Batta PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala and the same is taken on record.

As per the status report out of four persons named by the complainant, Navtej Singh Grewal and his wife Mami have been found to be innocent, whereas Lovepreet Kaur has been arrested. The fourth accused Sona has not been traced out till date as the complete address of the said person has not been furnished by the complainant.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court at this stage except to the extent that the Investigating Agency will make efforts to trace Sona, the fourth accused and proceed in accordance with law.
