Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No. 06 dated 12.01.2020, registered under Section 22(b) of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been involved in the present case; that co-accused Raj Kumar @ Raju son of Jagdish Rai, who was on a Scooty but on seeing the police party ran away from the spot and parked the Scooty in front of Joginder Medical Hall owned by him; that on checking, the alleged recovery of 800 tablets of Tramadol in a black coloured bag was recovered from the Scooty; that during interrogation said co-accused stated that the alleged tablets were purchased from petitioner-Raj Kumar @ Raju son of Kuldeep Ram; that the co-accused Raj Kumar @ Raju, has attached Invoice No. 129 dated 03.01.2020 indicating that the tablets were purchased from M/s G.S. Enterprises, which is

a valid seller, therefore, the petitioner has nothing to do with the present case and that said co-accused Raj Kumar @ Raju son of Jagdish Rai, has already been granted regular bail. The challan has been presented but the charges are yet to be framed.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the issued before the learned trial Court at an appropriate stage.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas before the learned trial Court at an appropriate stage.
