MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.109 dated 12.02.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 04.03.2020, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Ld. Counsel on instruction of the petitioner submits categorically that his client never sent the photographs of any Registration Certificate of the Swift Car, mentioned in the FIR by any WhatsApp message either from his phone or from that of anyone else, as claimed by the complainant.

Notice of motion for 29.06.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1 That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

2 That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from

*disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
3 That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Jaipal states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.03.2020 is made absolute.
