[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.01.2021, in CWP-22484-2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-22484-2020 was disposed of by directing that in case the petitioner filed a representation before the Transport Commissioner Haryana within one week, the same be decided within one month thereafter.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, states that representation filed by the petitioner was decided vide order Annexure R-1 dated 31.03.2021, partly accepting the claim of the petitioner. Copy thereof is stated to have already been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner. For that matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioner on the previous date also i.e. 27.09.2022.

[4] In view of the position noted above, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter. Accordingly, the instant petition is

*disposed of*as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge speaking order Annexure R-1 dated 31.03.2021 to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.
