VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to repair the leakage of the sewerage of pipe lines lying in the fields of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.4, the Sub Divisional Officer, Sewerage has informed that the said line already stands repaired and that there is no leakage of sewerage. The aforesaid assertion is not controverted by the counsel for the petitioner.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Insofar the aspect of repair of the leaking sewerage system is concerned, there are counter allegations levelled by

the State, hence, without commenting on the merits of the *inter se* claim, the petitioner is at liberty to take recourse to the appropriate alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law for seeking such compensation, if any.
